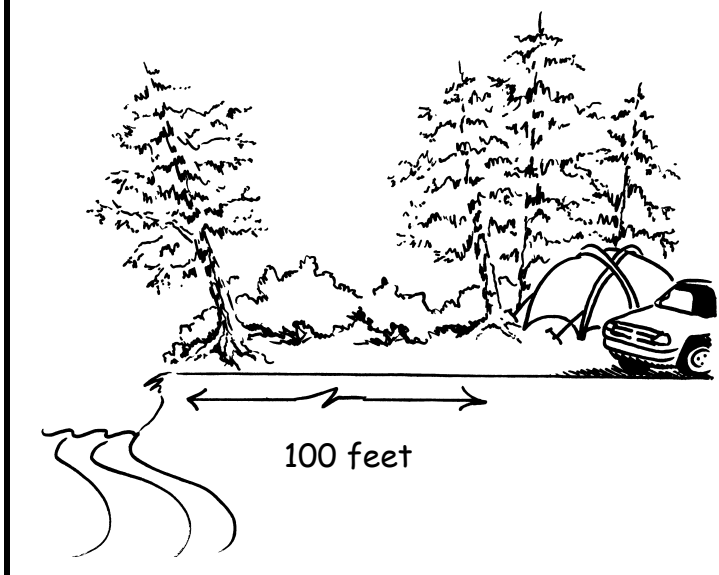


RESPECT THE RIVER

Protect soil & plants

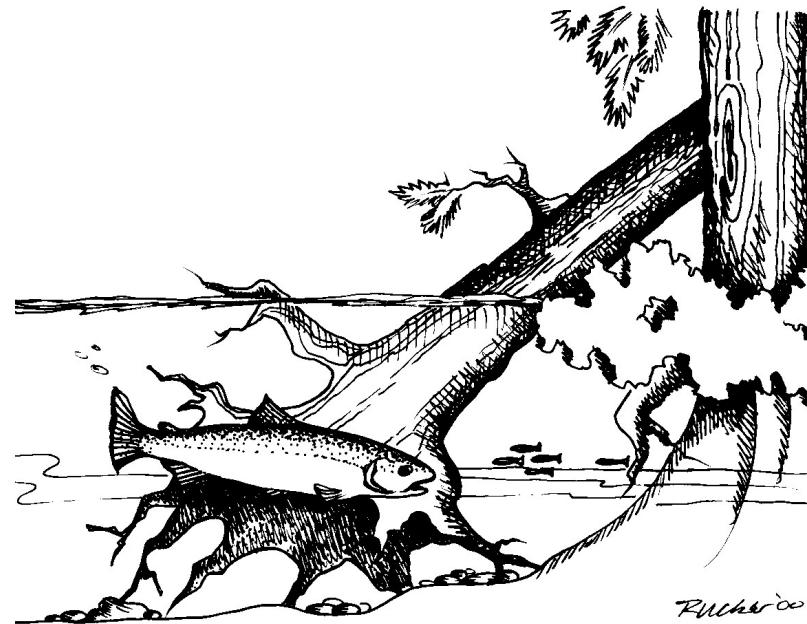
Keep campsites & vehicles at least 100 feet from water.



Let sleeping logs lie

Fallen trees and small pieces of driftwood provide habitat for fish!

- Use a camp stove for cooking.
- If you must build a fire, use an existing fire ring, keep the fire small, and bring your own firewood.

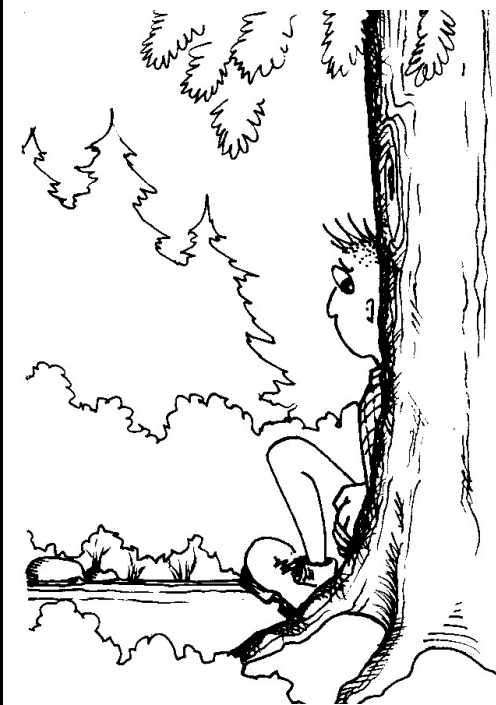


Know how to go to the bathroom in the woods.

Birds do it.

Let's do it right.

- Take 200 steps away from the water and campsites.
- Dig a hole 6 to 8 inches deep.
- Bury your waste and toilet paper.
- Cover the hole.
