

## TRAIL TO LASALLE CANYON



One of the more popular canyons for photographers. This canyon is quite a long walk from the Visitor Center parking lot, but great for avid hikers. This canyon features a waterfall that is active most of the year. You can exit this canyon from a trail on the west or the east side of the waterfall by walking behind the actual waterfall. This is also a gorgeous icefall in the winter!

**LENGTH FROM THE VISITOR CENTER:** 2.00 miles

**DIFFICULTY:** Hard (from the Visitor Center) Moderate (from the Parkman's Plain parking lot)

**PARKING:** Park at the Lower Park parking lot, the Lodge or and the Parkman's Plain parking lot located along Route 71.

**WATERFALL:** Yes

**TOP VIEW:** No

**INTERIOR CANYON VIEW:** Yes

**WILDLIFE:** Birdwatching, squirrel, rabbit, white tail deer, reptiles, amphibians and waterfowl.

**VIEW:** Illinois River, Owl Canyon Overlook.

**CONNECTING TRAILS:** Tonty Canyon, Owl Canyon Overlook, Hidden Canyon, Lonetree Canyon, Sandstone Overlook.
