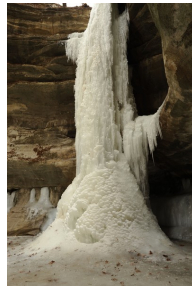


TRAIL TO ST. LOUIS CANYON



The trail to St. Louis Canyon is one of the most popular in the park. You can hike to this canyon from the Lodge or Visitor Center in about 35 minutes (and see three other canyons along the way), or park in the lot just off of Route 178 and hike to the canyon in 10 minutes! It's worth the hike either way! This Canyon is a **must see in the winter** for its icefall! Icefalls are best seen from January through early March.



St. Louis Canyon

Is it raining lightly today?
If you have your camera with you - this may be the best time for hiking.
The trails are quiet, as most folks will not hike in the rain.
Some of the best photos are taken in overcast weather!
PLUS...the waterfall will be active during and just after it rains!

LENGTH FROM THE VISITOR CENTER: 1.5 miles

DIFFICULTY: Moderate (from the Visitor Center) Easy (from the Parking lot on Route 178)

PARKING: Park at the Lower Park parking lot, the Lodge or and Parking lot on Route 178

WATERFALL: Yes

TOP VIEW: No

INTERIOR CANYON VIEW: Yes

WILDLIFE: Birdwatching, squirrel, rabbit, white tail deer, reptiles, amphibians.
